Pradhan Mantri Matsya Kisan Samridhi Sah-Yojana (PM-MKSSY)

The Sub-scheme will be implemented as a Central Sector Sub scheme under the Central Sector Component of the PMMSY for formalization of the fisheries sector and supporting fisheries micro and small enterprises with an estimated outlay of over Rs. 6,000 crores over a period of next four years from FY 2023-24 to FY 2026-27 in all States. It aims for gradual formalization of fisheries sector with creation of a **National Fisheries Digital Platform** to provide work-based identities.

Eligible Beneficiaries

1. Fishers, Fish (Aquaculture) Farmers, Fish workers, Fish Vendors or such other person directly engaged in fisheries value chain.
2. Micro and Small enterprises in the form of Proprietary Firms, Partnership Firms and Companies registered in India, Societies, Limited Liability Partnerships (LLPs), Cooperatives, Federations, Village
3. Level Organizations like Self Help Groups (SHGs), Fish Farmers Producer Organizations (FFPOs) and Start-ups engaged in fisheries and aquaculture value chains. FFPOs also include Farmers Producer Organizations (FPOs).
4. Any other beneficiaries that may be included by the Department of Fisheries, GoI as targeted beneficiaries.

Key Components of the Scheme
1. Formalization of fisheries sector and facilitating access of fisheries micro enterprises to Government of India's programs for working capital financing
2. Facilitating adoption of aquaculture insurance
3. Supporting fisheries microenterprises to improve fisheries sector value chain efficiencies
4. Adoption and expansion of fish and fishery product safety and quality assurance systems
